Firing may be done and scored anytime between June 22, 2019 and August 15, 2019.

### **CLOSING DATE AND ENTRY SUBMISSIONS**

**Closing Date is August 15, 2019.** Roster and Score Sheets are to be electronically send to HQYM at anytime and all must be received by HQYM by the August 15, 2019 deadline.

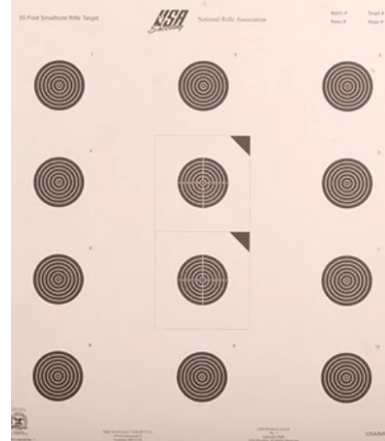
