

2019 ENCAMPMENT GEAR LIST

Quantity	
1	Green military-style sea bag. (A garment bag may be used for YM uniforms.) With luggage tag or marked.
1	Camouflage trousers or khaki trousers needed for the rappelling/climbing tower. (no exceptions)
1	Sleeping bag or 1-pillow and 2 flat sheets and 1- large blanket
1	Pair of boots or hiking sneakers needed for the rappelling/climbing tower. (no exceptions)
10 pair	Underwear
6	FEMALES--Bras, (recommended to bring 2 regular and 2 sport bras)
2	Red Young Marine National T-shirt Used for days of travel
1	Red DDR bracelet
6	Unit T-shirts. <i>FEMALES MAY NOT WEAR WHITE T-SHIRTS FOR P.T.</i>
6	Black, khaki or blue jean shorts. Shorts must be no more than 2" above knee cap. No spandex/yoga type
1	Swimming suit for boys. (must be no more than 2" above knee cap)
1	Swimming suit for girls. (Must be one-piece) No exceptions.)
1	Plain grey sweatshirt and sweat pants (Used for cold weather, mainly in the evening when it is colder)
2 pair	Running shoes
2 pair	Black or green socks
10 pair	White socks
1	Sunblock/screen (SPF 30 or higher) (Enough to last the week)
1	Flashlight with extra batteries
1	Insect repellent (Enough to last the week)
3	Towels and wash cloths
1 pair	Shower shoes
1	Rain gear
1	50 oz. hydration system (Camelback or similar) PREFERRED. (canteens/water bottles acceptable)
1 set	Personal hygiene items (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hair brush and/or comb, deodorant, lotion, shampoo, mesh laundry bag, feminine hygiene products-if applicable, hair bands-if applicable)
1 set	Pencil, pen and highlighter.
Medication	Must be in original prescription bottle with explicit directions for dosage. If YM does not have original bottles for each prescription, the YM will be sent home at the parent's expense.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. Male Young Marines must arrive with a fresh haircut. Female Young Marines hair and fingernails will have no enhancements such as color or extensions.
2. Young Marines will not bring radios, lighters, knives, paint guns, t-shirts in poor taste (as determined by any registered Adult Volunteer), jewelry other than watch, religious medal or gold post earrings (which must be removed during P.T.) for females, or any form of electronics (including e-cigarettes or vapes). These items are not authorized and will be confiscated for the duration of the encampment and returned prior to departure. (An exception is made for the YM PAO who may have a digital camera.)
3. We understand the need to travel with cell phones, however, all cell phones will be collected at the beginning of the event and returned at the conclusion of the event.
4. Young Marines are responsible for their own property. THE YOUNG MARINES OF THE MARINE CORPS LEAGUE AND ADULT VOLUNTEERS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY STOLEN, LOST, OR MISSING MONEY OR PERSONAL ITEMS.
