Method of Disbursement:	The Scholarships are presented at the annual American Veteran's Center Banquet. <i>*Recipients must attend the American Veteran's Center Banquet to personally receive the scholarship.</i>

Please include name of High School and name of college/university or trade/technical school attending.• Standard Resume stating your objectives, qualifications, chronology of achievements inside and outside Young Marines, hobbies and other interests.• 500-word Essay on any World War II Marine and how this Marine's story influenced you.• Full-length photograph of applicant in Young Marine uniform.
