- Pearl Harbor and USS Arizona Memorial – The memorial is currently closed. They still offer the boat tour around the memorial, but you are not able to get off and look around. Tickets are required and can be purchased for \$1.50 at <https://www.recreation.gov/ticket/facility/233338>. Get your tickets early, because they go fast! They do provide tickets on-site for free, but they are not guaranteed to have enough.
