New Member Gear List: Recruit and Poolee  
\$400 total in enrollment fees for Recruits as follows:

1. \$75 Non-refundable enrollment deposit pays for the following:
  - Registration with the National organization
  - Including subscription to Quarterly Espirit magazine
  - Registration with the Local Organization
  - Recruit Guide Book
  - Liability Insurance coverage for unit activities
  - Ages 10 and under: Activity Book

A red string bag will be loaned to carry gear--must be returned on leaving the program or upon graduation.
  
2. \$325 due approximately week 5 of Recruit Training pays for the following for graduates:
  - Sea bag (aka duffle bag)
  - Rucksack (aka backpack)
  - Ribbon rack and ribbons earned
  - Boot shine kit
  - Hydration pack (aka camelbak)
  - 1 pair of jungle boots
  - 1 BDU blouse (aka camo shirt)
  - 1 BDU pair of trousers
  - 1 pair black PT shorts with YM logo
  - 1 pair of boot bands
  - 1 camo cover (aka hat)
  - Web belt
  - 1 OD (olive drab) green YM t-shirt with YM logo
  - 1 dark green YM t-shirt with YM logo
  - 3 name tapes (blouse, trouser, and hydration source)
  - 1 Young Marines tape (OD green)
  - 1 red national t-shirt
  - 1 yellow regimental t-shirt
  - Unit arc shoulder patch
  - Costs of sewing patches and name tapes on first issue uniform
  - DDR cards
  
3. Additional fee--encampment (required overnight camping trip) fee--varies depending on location--will be announced in advance--under \$50--covers:
  - costs of food provided at encampment (meals and snacks)
  - rent of campground and facilities
  - any programs offered/equipment required

Note: The Young Marines is a nonprofit 501(c)3 organization. Most of our funding comes from our families. Some comes from sponsors, grants, or other funding, but most from our families. In order to minimize the costs, the unit schedules regular opportunities for fundraising. These help raise funds for operating costs and those participating in the fundraisers (many of which are scheduled on weekends) will have a portion of the funds raised applied to their own accounts to defray expenses.

Poolees pay the \$75 registration fee. If they join the next Recruit Training, they will pay \$325 approximately 5 weeks into the Recruit Training. If they opt to remain a Poolee for more than 6 months, a re-registration fee may be due.
